

P111a BISTRO Project Status (8)

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BISTRO (B-field In STar forming Region Observations) is an international research project to make sub-millimeter linear polarization images of nearby star forming regions as a series of 3 consecutive EAO/JCMT Large Programs, and it involves 148 researchers in Canada, China, Japan, Korea, Taiwan, UK, Vietnam and the East Asian Observatory. This paper reports an update of the research program including; a) progress of the data taking (BISTRO-1 complete, BISTRO-2 nearing completion, BISTRO-3 started), b) progress of publication (7 1st-generation, 2 2nd-generation, and 2 review papers), and c) an emerging picture of the evolution of magnetized ISM towards star formation.
